Ned Turnbull moderated an interactive program that used hypotheticals to explore lawyers' confidentiality and disclosure duties in the context of non-clients' misunderstanding and mistakes.

The program addressed the difference between ethics and professionalism; dealing with unrepresented persons who may misunderstand a lawyer's role; negotiation ethics; litigators' disclosure duties in the face of litigation adversaries' or courts' misunderstanding, mistakes or scrivener's errors.
